An excerpt from our Obligation:

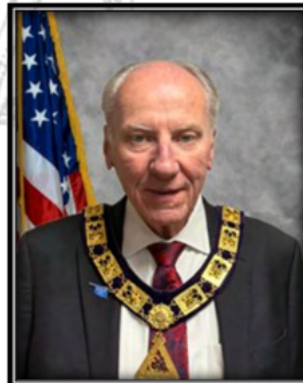
I will support the Constitution, and obey the statutes, rules and regulations of this order, and the By-Laws of Broken Arrow Lodge Number 2673.

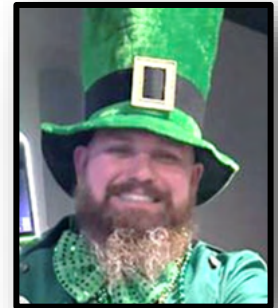

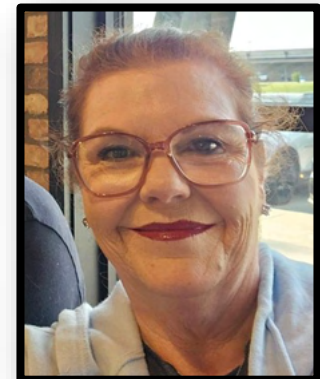

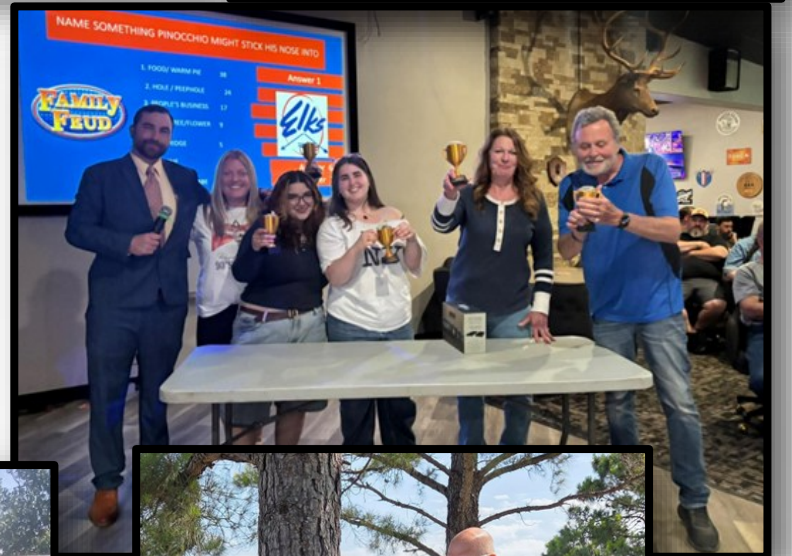
LADY ELK OF THE MONTH REBECCA OSBORNE
